He is researcher archaeologist of CNR, at the Institute for Archaeological and Monumental Heritage (IBAM). Since the academic year 1998-1999 and up to now, he has been Adjunct Professor at the School of Specialization in Archaeology of Matera of the University of Basilicata, in the discipline of “Methodology and Excavation Technique” and “Methodology of the Archaeological Research”. Since the academic year 2004-2005 and up to now, he has been Adjunct Professor at the University of Basilicata, in the discipline of “Landscape Archaeology”. He develops several educational paths, among which the evolution of the archaeological research field methods, the landscape archaeology and the informative and territorial system, the setting-out and the methods of field survey, the strategies of archaeological tracks documentation, the interpretation, the chronology and the edition of the data, the IT applied to archaeology (with particular regard to the GIS platforms). Currently, he is working to the study of aspects concerning the archaeological research methodologies (survey and excavation) and he is carrying on some projects aimed to the ancient landscapes reconstruction. He is editor of several publications in the field of Classical and of Landscape Archaeology. He is member of the scientific Committee of the Journal “*Siris. Studi e Ricerche della Scuola di Specializzazione in Archeologia di Matera*”.
